

REGULATIONS: Detailed regulations will be included in the Emerging Young Artist Contract, provided after acceptance by the jury.

1. Two-dimensional work must be appropriately matted, framed and priced for display and sale.
2. Booths must be manned by juried Exhibitor(s) throughout the entire two-day festival.
3. Work must be consistent with that submitted to the jury. Compliance will be monitored. CCAFI reserves the right to remove any work that differs from that juried, as well as any work or display deemed inappropriate.
4. All work must be original and produced by the exhibitor by hand or with appropriate tools. No buy-sell or imports. Use of kits, molds, patterns, plans, prefabricated forms or other commercial methods is not permitted. Work should have been created within the past two years.
5. The entire display must be contained within the confines of the 12x12 space provided for that purpose. A 10x10 tent with sides will be provided for your use by CCAFI, along with appropriate display equipment. The space should be shared by all Emerging Young Artist Exhibitors in displaying their work.
6. Exhibitors are required to prominently display an Artist Information Statement, disclosing materials and processes used in the creation of the work displayed and sold.
7. Displays should be set up by 9:30 a.m. Saturday and 10:30 a.m. Sunday, and may not be taken down prior to closing each day under any circumstances.
8. Display of your own business cards, signs and banners are encouraged, providing they do not block walkways or access to the booth.
9. Name tags should be worn and official booth signs displayed at all times.
10. Sale of promotional items is strictly prohibited.

FAILURE TO COMPLY may result in forfeiture of awards and removal from the Festival.

IMAGE ENTRY GUIDELINES & JURY CRITERIA: CCAFI will only accept digital images for jury review (see *Technical Specifications below*).

IMAGE SUBMISSION may be by e-mail or non-returnable CD Rom. Be sure the CD has been finalized. It is the applicant's responsibility that media be readable on both Macintosh and Windows based computers.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS: Images must be formatted to the following specifications.

1. Save all images as Baseline Standard JPEG. Do not save as a Progressive JPEG. Images must be less than 2.0 MB in size.
2. Size images to 1920 pixels on the longest side to take advantage of the full image quality potential during projection..
3. Save images in RGB color.
4. Images are no longer required to have black masks and do not have to be formatted into a square. For consistency it is recommended not to mix images that have and do not have black masks in a single application.
4. Each image file must be labeled with your name and a number that coincides with the description provided on a separate sheet. (Examples: smith1.jpg; smith2.jpg). Descriptions should include materials, technique, dimensions and price. Colorscape is able to provide assistance with preparing images and pricing your work if required. Call or e-mail if you have questions.
5. If you are submitting images on a CD Rom, label the CD with your full name and category for which you are being juried.

PURPOSE: The purpose of the Francis K. Wilcox Scholarship Award is to put young Chenango area artists in touch with the professional art world. By experiencing a professional show as an exhibitor, it is hoped that they will broaden their knowledge of a wide spectrum of media and artistic output.

This program is intended to honor and give public recognition to, as well as to stimulate competition among, students who have attained high achievement in a variety of media.

In addition to receiving a scholarship award, recipients will display and sell their work in a booth provided by CCAFI and participate fully with other exhibitors to give them the experience of taking part in a juried art festival alongside professional artists.

ELIGIBILITY: All high school art students (2009-2010 academic year) living *and/or* attending school in Chenango county are invited to apply for consideration for Colorscape's 2010 Francis K. Wilcox Scholarship Awards. Eligibility is not limited to public schools, but includes home-schooled, private and parochial students.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Applications should be post-marked by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, May 14th, 2010. Submission of an application is a commitment to jury only.

AWARDS: The 2010 Francis K. Wilcox Scholarship Awards of \$350 per qualifying Emerging Young Artist (maximum of two per year) accepted by the jury will be presented at the complimentary Awards Breakfast on the Sunday of the festival weekend. In addition to cash awards, \$100 gift certificates for Golden Artist Colors products will be awarded.

SALES: No commission on sales is retained by CCAFI. Exhibitors are required by law to display a current NYS Sales Tax Certificate (provided by CCAFI) and to collect state and local sales tax. Assistance will be provided by CCAFI. Sales records should be submitted to CCAFI following the Festival and CCAFI will file with NYS Tax Dept.

MAIL TO COLORSCAPE BY MAY 14th, 2010:

- Brief biography outlining your artistic accomplishments and plans for the future.
- Three images (see *guidelines*) representative of your work.
- SASE (2 oz. postage)

JURY DECISION: Notification of the jury's decision will be mailed by **MAY 28th, 2010**.

SIGNED CONTRACTS MUST BE RECEIVED BY JULY 2nd, 2010. Failure to meet deadline will result the space being given to the next applicant on the jury's list.

JURY & BOOTH FEES: Colorscape's \$15 jury fee and \$175 booth fee have been waived for Emerging Young Artists. Juried exhibitors will share a 10x10 booth during the two-day event.

JURY DECISIONS ARE BASED ON: 1) Creativity; 2) Workmanship; 3) Continuity of work; and 4) Your written biographical essay.

The jury will view submitted images, application forms and essays. Decisions of the jury are final.

CANCELLATION: In the event of a natural disaster or other circumstances preventing this event, the decision to cancel the festival during its course may be made by the CCAFI Board of Directors. In the event of cancellation, CCAFI will not be held responsible for any cost(s) incurred or loss of potential earnings.

BOOTH ASSIGNMENTS: Use of the Emerging Young Artist Booth is restricted solely to the Exhibitors to whom the space is assigned. Only work consistent with that accepted by the jury is to be displayed or sold. Exhibitors will be notified of space assignment prior to the event.

CCAFI will provide a 10x10 tent with sides, display equipment, booth signs and name tags.

Thunderstorms are a common occurrence in September but Colorscape takes place **RAIN OR SHINE**.
