



Colorscape Chenango Arts Festival September 7&8, 2024 Non-Profit Row Guidelines

Welcome to Colorscape's Non-Profit Row. The idea is simple: we offer space within our Festival to local non-profit groups and organizations so that they can present themselves and their mission to the community. In exchange, those organizations offer a free arts-related activity to our community to create any even deeper and varied arts experience. It's a win-win! We encourage all non-profit organizations in Chenango County to apply to participate.

The Non-Profit Row is located within the Festival along the south side of West Main Street, alongside Guernsey Memorial Library, and across the street from Kids' Art Zone and Art Zone Stage. Non-Profit Row becomes a great bridge for attendees walking from the main Festival to the Kids' Art Zone and the family programming stage.

Guidelines and expectations:

- Non-profits will be assigned a 10 foot deep and 12 foot wide space in which to set up their booth. (If you have a preference for a neighbor, please let us know.)
- Organizations must provide all their own supplies, such as tables and chairs. A canopy is required. Please come prepared for any weather and stake or weight your canopy down. You are also required by law to bring a Fire Extinguisher. (But we do not have the capacity to either inspect or enforce this.)
- Non-profits are expected to be open for the very same hours as the Festival: Saturday 10am-6pm and Sunday 11am-5pm. Non-profits that wish to only participate on one day must find another non-profit with which to share the space and fee. Booths should be staffed the entire time. Please ask a neighbor to keep an eye on your booth if you need to take a brief break. Note that you must participate both days.
- Non-profits are free to promote their own mission in any way they choose.
- But non-profits are also expected to promote the mission of Colorscape by offering a free arts activity to members of our audience.
- Enjoy the weekend, and thank you for making Colorscape even bigger and better!

Fee: \$20 participation fee per organization

To apply: Participation in the Festival must be approved by the Board of Directors at the July 10, 2024 meeting. Applications must be received via email to director@colorscape.org by July 5, 2024.
